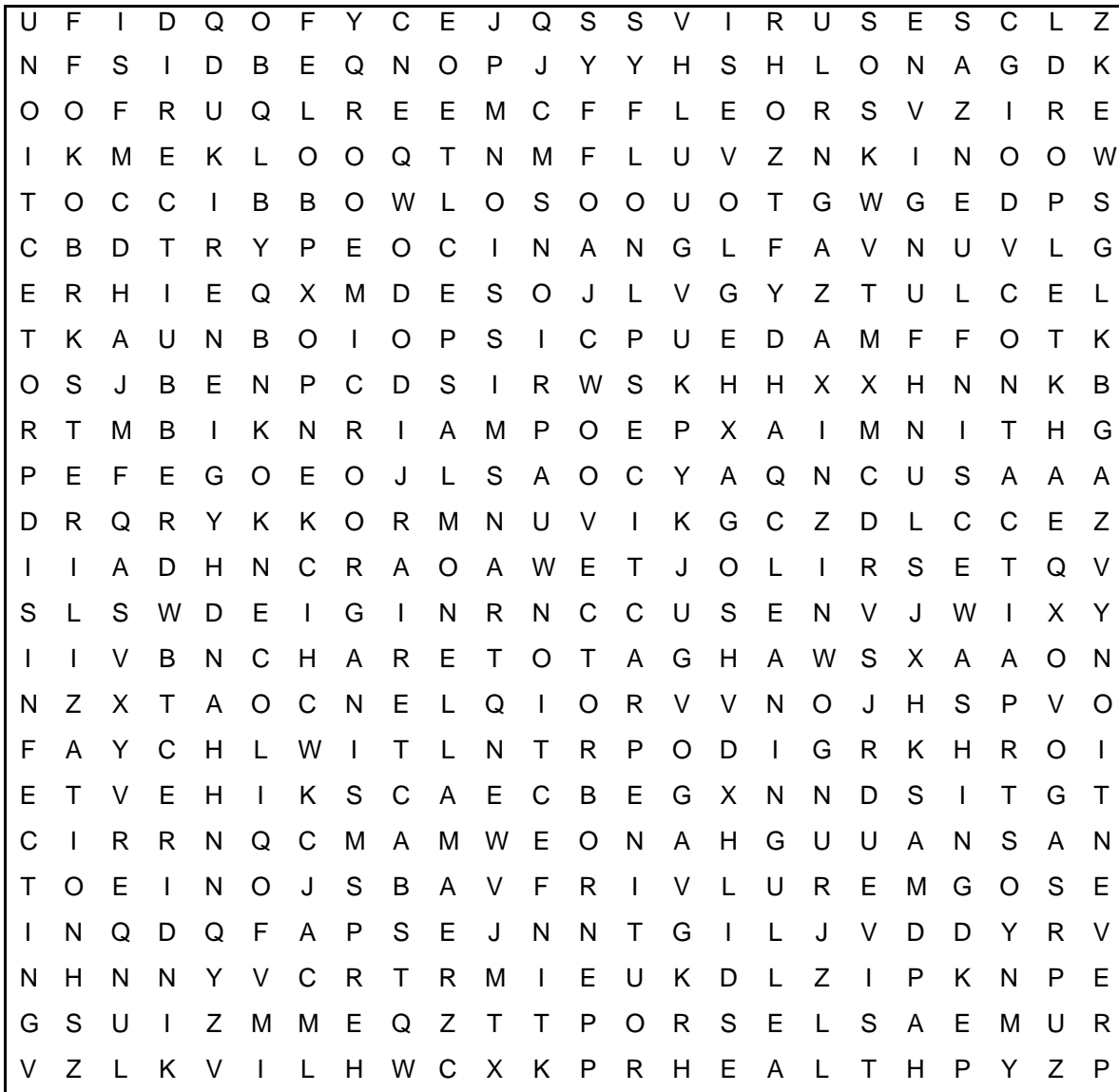

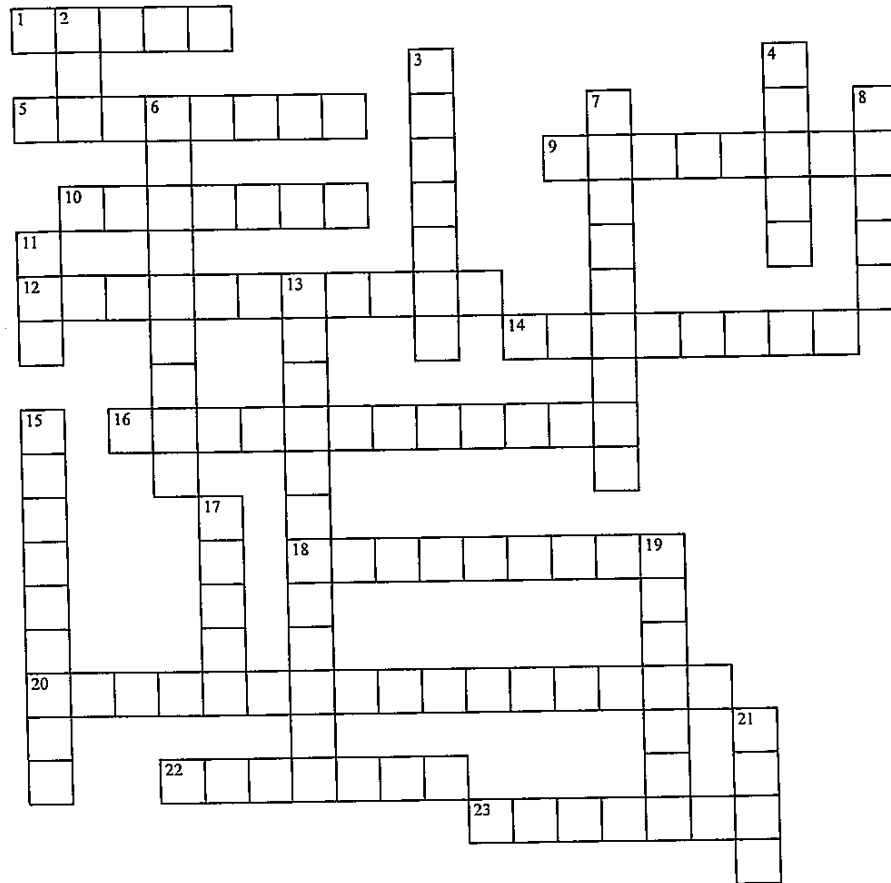

1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of transmission describes the process of infection transmission and involves an infectious agent, reservoir, portal of exit, mode of transmission, portal of entry, and susceptible host.
2. This acronym has recently replaced the term 'nosocomial' when describing infections that are associated with health care settings.

17. This acronym represents the group of experts from across the province of Ontario who provide best practice in infection prevention and control documents to health care professionals.
18. The respiratory illness caused by a virus that can be prevented by getting the annual immunization.
19. \_\_\_\_\_ based hand rub is the most effective way to inactivate microorganisms living on your hands, when your hands are not visibly soiled.
20. \_\_\_\_\_ week takes place during the third week of October annually and is an opportunity to celebrate the hard work that ICPs do everyday.

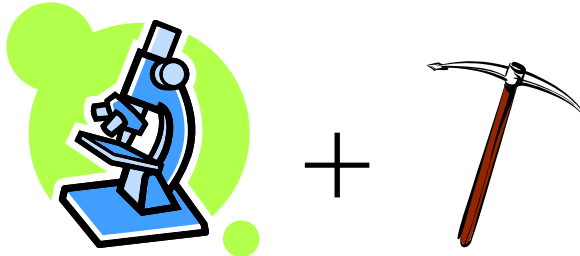

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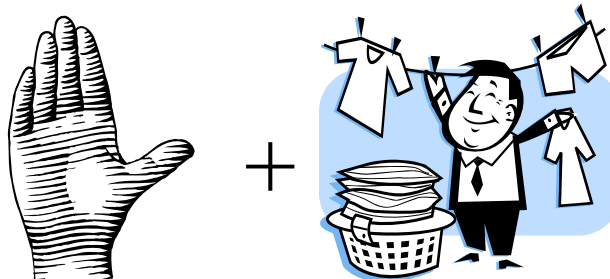
